ORDINANCE NO. 360 VOTE YES OR NO	ORDINANCE NO. 361 VOTE YES OR NO
Ordinance No. 360, adopted by the Shelby County Board of Commissioners on June 2, 2008, proposes the Shelby County Charter be amended to change the two four-year term limitation for the County Commissioners and County Mayor to three four-year terms; to create the county charter offices of Shelby County Sheriff, Shelby County Trustee, Shelby County Register, Shelby County Clerk, and Shelby County Assessor; to assign the duties and functions to the county charter officers that were performed by the former constitutional Sheriff, Trustee, Register, County Clerk, and Assessor, respectively; to add provisions giving titles to the county charter officers, establishing qualifications for holding office, setting the method for determining their compensation, requiring they be elected to a four-year term, limited to three consecutive terms, providing for their removal and recall, and establishing the procedure for filling vacancies in those offices; and to delete a section referring to the former constitutional Sheriff; all amendments becoming effective September 1, 2010, but effective September 1, 2012, as to the Shelby County Assessor who shall serve a two-year term beginning September 1, 2012, then a four-year term commencing with the 2014 general election and each four years thereafter. Shall these amendments be approved?	Ordinance No. 361, adopted by the Shelby County Board of Commissioners on June 2, 2008, proposes the Shelby County Charter be amended to delete Exhibit "A", a duplication of the Civil Service Act ordinance; to amend Sections 1.02, 2.02, 2.03, 2.04, 2.06, 3.05, 3.07, and 5.10 so as to vest county charter officers with power to conduct governmental affairs, address the nomination of County Commissioners to fill vacancies, change the method for filling a vacancy in the County Mayor's office, and clarify application of purchasing procedures, effective date of ordinances, and salary increases requiring two-thirds vote ordinance; to authorize the County Commission to set by ordinance exemptions to the residency requirement for County officials and employees, and to set by resolution the length of employment for CPAs conducting County audits, County Commission chairman's salary, budget requirements and procedures, and date County Mayor must submit consolidated budget; and to forbid county elected officials from holding another compensated elective office, provide for recall of county officials, and set the successions of authority following a disaster; all amendments becoming effective September 1, 2008. Shall these amendments be approved?
