## **EARLY VOTING STARTS WEDNESDAY, FEB. 12 ONE EARLY VOTING LOCATION CHANGE**

Memphis, Tenn. (Feb. 6, 2020) Early Voting for the Presidential Preference Primary and County Primary elections will begin Feb. 12.

“All 26 Early Voting locations around the county will open Wednesday,” said Linda Phillips, administrator of elections for the Shelby County Election Commission (SCEC). Most locations will be open from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m. Hours are different on Saturdays and at the polling place located at 157 Poplar Ave., inside the downtown office of SCEC.

All polling locations will be closed on Sundays and on Monday, Feb., 17 in observance of President’s Day.

There has been one Early Voting polling location change. Those who chose to vote at Annunciation Church on Macon Road in Cordova must choose an alternate polling place. A polling place was added at Mt. Pisgah M.B. Church, located at 1234 Pisgah Rd., Memphis 38106. During Early Voting people can vote at any of the 26 locations.

“We hadn’t planned on changing the location, but the church notified us that space would no longer be available,” Phillips said. “We found an alternate location that I think is better situated for residents in Fisherville and Eads, where they didn’t have a nearby Early Voting site.”
